INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT ONE.

(18 U.S.C. § 224(a) - Conspiracy to Influence Sporting Contests by Bribery)

A. GENERAL ALLEGATIONS.

At all times material to this Indictment:

1. The principal activity of individual bookmakers and bookmaking businesses consisted of accepting and recording wagers on sporting contests, paying monies to bettors who placed winning wagers, and collecting monies from bettors who placed losing wagers. Individual bookmakers and bookmaking businesses ordinarily used a "point spread" so that bettors could place wagers based on the point spread of a sporting contest rather than simply betting on which team would win. The point spread was the predicted scoring difference between the two opponents in a sporting contest. The point spread defined which team was the favorite, and which team was the "underdog," that is, the predicted losing team. In order for a bettor to win a wager placed on the favorite team, the favorite team had to win by more than the spread number. In order for a bettor to win a wager placed on the "underdog" team, the "underdog" team had to either win the contest outright, or lose by less than the spread number. For example, if Team A was the "underdog" team by three points, then a bettor who bet on Team A would have won the wager if Team A either won the game outright, or if Team A lost the game by one or two points.

2. A football or basketball game could be "fixed" by, among other ways, a player's agreement to influence the game's outcome by deliberately limiting the number of points scored by his team so that people gambling on the score of the game can profit. Such a scheme, customarily called "point shaving," entailed an effort by a player who was usually a member of the favorite team to ensure by their play during the game, or by some other means, that their team scored only a certain number of points during the game. The number of points to be scored was determined by what the point spread was on that particular game.

B. THE CONSPIRACY.

1. From at least in or about December 2004, and continuing through at least in or about December 2006, in the Eastern District of Michigan and elsewhere, GHAZI MANNI, MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, ADAM RYAN CUOMO, KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate and agree with each other, and with persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to carry into effect a scheme in commerce to influence by bribery various sporting contests, that is, football games and basketball games between the University of Toledo men's football and basketball teams and various opponents, with knowledge that the purpose of such scheme was to influence by bribery those contests.

C. MANNER, MEANS AND METHODS OF THE CONSPIRACY.

The manner, means and methods employed by the defendants, GHAZI MANNI, MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, ADAM RYAN CUOMO, KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to effect the objects of the conspiracy were as follows:

1. It was a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI, MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, ADAM RYAN CUOMO, KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did agree upon and carry into effect a "point shaving" scheme to "fix" University of Toledo men's

football and basketball games during the time period from at least in or about Fall 2004 until in or about Fall 2006.

2. It was further a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI, and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did directly and indirectly pay money, and other things of value, to ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, in return for providing information to them which information was not in the public domain and which related to the likely performance of the University of Toledo men's football and basketball teams and their opponents in various sporting contests, for the purpose of deciding whether an attempt should be made to "fix" a particular game in order to generate money for the conspirators.

3. It was further a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did directly and indirectly pay money and other things of value to ADAM RYAN CUOMO, KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, in return for facilitating the "point shaving" scheme to "fix" University of Toledo men's football and basketball games by aiding in attempting to recruit other University of Toledo men's football and men's basketball team members to join the conspiracy.

4. It was further a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did directly and indirectly pay money and other things of value to KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF

LASHON PAYNE, and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, in return for these members using their ability as players to control events during games to attempt to ensure that the University of Toledo teams would score a certain number of points determined by the point spread.

5. It was further a part of the conspiracy that KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein, and other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, would and did receive and accept, and agree to receive and accept, money and other things of value in return for being induced to use their abilities as players to control events during games to attempt to ensure that the University of Toledo teams would score a certain number of points determined by the point spread.

6. It was further a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI, Defendant herein, would and did use interstate telephone facilities between Michigan and Ohio and elsewhere to converse with ADAM RYAN CUOMO, KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT, ANTON DU'ANE CURRIE, KASHIF LASHON PAYNE, HARVEY LAMONT McDOUGLE JR., and QUINTON JAMES BROUSSARD, Defendants herein.

7. It was further a part of the conspiracy that GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did use interstate telephone facilities between Michigan and elsewhere to place wagers on certain University of Toledo men's football and basketball games, knowing that these games were "fixed," to obtain money for the conspirators in the "point shaving" scheme.

8. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Sunday, November 20, 2005,

GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$42,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and the University of South Carolina.

9. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Sunday, November 27, 2005, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$10,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Southern Methodist University.

10. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Saturday, December 3, 2005, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$10,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Northern Illinois University.

11. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Saturday, December 17, 2005, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$44,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and St. Bonaventure University.

12. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Wednesday, December 21, 2005, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$21,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and East Carolina University.

13. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Wednesday, January 4, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$10,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of

Toledo and Kent State University.

14. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Saturday, January 7, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$15,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and the University of Akron.

15. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Sunday, January 15, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$17,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Bowling Green State University.

16. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Wednesday, January 18, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$21,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Miami University (of Ohio).

17. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Tuesday, January 24, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$40,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Northern Illinois University.

18. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Wednesday, February 1, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$40,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Western Michigan University.

19. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Saturday, February 4, 2006,

GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$20,500 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Central Michigan University.

20. It was further a part of the conspiracy that on or about Tuesday, February 7, 2006, GHAZI MANNI and MITCHELL EDWARD KARAM, Defendants herein, would and did wager approximately \$20,000 on the outcome of the men's basketball game between the University of Toledo and Kent State University.
